


FINANCIAL ISSUES

NEW BANK DETAILS

Thank you Charles!


SUBSCRIPTIONS

NEW SEASON

The season officially begins on 1st October, and follows the structure we started last year. A fixture list for Championship is in this magazine. Games must be started by the date shown, but if both players agree you can play games earlier if you want to.


As you will see, we have slightly simplified things with the experience of a year of the new structure. The differentiation between Social & Occasional seemed unnecessary and so we now have simply Championship (better, on reflection, than Shield) and Social. The Divisions remain self-selecting with the simple qualifying criteria that if you have played in Championship and completed your games you can stay unless you ask to leave, while players in Social or those in Championship who default without good reason will have to show that they have completed two games before they can be admitted or readmitted to Championship.



Social Members should contact each other to arrange games whenever they wish.

SCHEMING MIND STANDARD CHESS LEAGUE

Our final two matches were in play at the time of the last magazine. Despite being awarded a 10-0 win over Team Great Britain as they were unable to field enough players, we lost to SCCA $4^{1/2}$ - $5^{1/2}$, and, although not yet finished we have also lost to Chess Warriors as the match stands at $2^{1/2}$ - $6^{1/2}$ with a game to finish. This means we are almost certain to be relegated back to our old level in Division 4, but at least there we will face opposition more at our level. Our Team has played well for two seasons in a Division generally above our level and deserve our thanks for representing us in this League.

CONGRATULATIONS TO ANDREW YATES 2024/2025 CHAMPION

Andrew Yates has reclaimed the Ivor Davies Trophy in emphatic fashion with 100% score.

The next 4 places were very close with Michael Hall edging 2nd place by ½ point. Jon Turner & David Nye tied for 3rd, with Jon getting the place on the Sonnenborn-Berger tie break, with Lisa Battye was just a further half point behind them.

Richard Cleaves & John Druce brought up the rear, each beating the other once so their tie break went right down to SM Ratings.

One or two results were agreed or claimed at the last minute after failing to be completed in time, and one match was scored 0-0 after no result was notified.

The Divisions are largely self-selecting in that anyone in Championship who completes their games will stay in that group unless they choose to drop into Social. Anyone in Social, or anyone in Championship who defaults without good reason must complete two games before they can be re-admitted to Championship

The New Season

Our season runs from October to July, with games played in Championship according to the Fixture List below. It is your responsibility to make sure that all games are completed by 31st July 2026 and results reported to me. Results that are not notified may be scored as a loss to both players. Please let me know if you were playing White or Black when notifying results in case of a tie. If you cannot complete a game or agree a result then a game may be submitted for adjudication but there is a charge for this for us to have access to the BFCC adjudication panel.

Ties are decided initially by the Baumbach Tie Break, then the Sonneborn-Berger Tie Break in accordance with ICCF procedures. These have been explained but if you are not clear what these systems are then email the Secretary for enlightenment.

In Championship you must play your games on Scheming Mind, or at least by email. Other Divisions can also use post, telephone, or fax. If you are playing on Scheming Mind then the time limit is 30 days plus 1 day per move made, and this is maintained by the web server along with holiday leave etc. and it doesn't allow any leeway so if you break the time limit you lose!

If you use the scoresheets then the time columns are: 'R' is the date that you *received* your opponent's move; 'S' is the date you *send* your reply; 'T' is the *total time* used to date. This way you and your opponent can immediately see where you stand in relation to the time limit.

Championship Fixture List 2025 / 2026

There are seven players in this Division which requires 7 rounds, though one player will have a bye in each round. We don't want to start a round any later than March to ensure there is time to complete it before the season ends so the first two rounds begin fairly close together. Not all rounds are due to begin on 1st of the month to avoid weekend starts and in the case of January the Christmas period. The dates given below are the latest that each round should start, but if both players agree there is no reason why you should not start games earlier.

When reporting results please let me know whether you were white or black in case of tie breaks later on.

Last season a few rounds were never started. If you play on SM you use a computer, so you can presumably put some kind of reminder in your calendar that will automatically alert you to the dates when rounds are due to start.

The date given is the latest date by which the round should start.

The first named player in each fixture is responsible for starting the games.






Hopefully the games will return to their usual quality in future issues.


